Time + Exposure = Opportunity for Manipulation

A. Manipulation

- Testing the waters Fishing for suckers
- The offender may break a minor rule to see your reaction
- May attempt to make requests in violation that are difficult to refuse
- Sympathy to get you emotionally connected/easily manipulated
- Do not become an advocate for the prisoner
- The touch System, Things that we take for granted on the outside may have a different meaning on the inside
- Do not become complacent!
 - A. Do not forget where you are!
 - B. When you see it... Remind your Brother the danger of becoming complacent
 - C. Role Model appropriate behavior at all times.
- No Means No Do not be afraid to say no!!
- The offenders know the rules better than we do.

B. Trafficking

- Trafficking is Illegal
- The simplicity of trafficking
- Problem's that have occurred Around The State involving Kairos volunteers
- We are being watched 174 cameras 24/7

- Trafficking is probably the easiest violation to get drawn into
- Never Give or Receive Anything from an Offender **Period!!**
- Once your become in violation they own you !!!!

C. The Boundaries of the Ministry

- Showing Gods Love in the Prison Environment
- The more Anonymous we are the better, The focus should be on **GOD**, and not on ourselves
- Leave your ego at the foot of the Cross
- Encourage our Guests Show them the Face of Jesus
- Do not show favoritism , all are Gods children
- Remember the Wardens Rules must be followed at all times
Regardless of what you may think or feel!!

D. Summary

- **Never forget where you are!!**
- **Remember that the Offender may be projecting a false image of himself. And You do not REALLY KNOW HIM !**
- **Be aware of the Prison Rules and follow them at all times !**
- **Do not be afraid to say NO... They understand !!!**
- **Remember that our conduct in the free world may have a different meaning inside those walls. (Both Words, and Mannerisms)**
