**A SUPPORT WEEKEND FOR
WOMEN WHO HAVE A
RELATIVE OR FRIEND WHO
IS, OR HAS BEEN,
INCARCERATED**

The purpose of Kairos Outside is to demonstrate God's grace and love through Christian support for women who have relatives or friends who are, or who have been incarcerated.



Kairos Outside is designed to support the families of men and women who are or have been incarcerated in the country's state and federal correctional facilities, as well as county jails and youth offender programs. The spouses, parents and other relatives of the incarcerated often "do time" right along with their incarcerated ones. It is important for them to know that they are not alone and that there is a Christian community that cares. This support is first provided in a safe environment with Christian people during a Kairos Outside weekend. During this weekend, the guests will also have a chance to interact with other women who are in similar situations and learn how to form small groups to support and give them strength in their life's journey.



COMMONLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

What happens on a Kairos Outside Weekend?

The weekend is a series of talks by women sharing their life's journey. Each guest has the opportunity to review the talk in small family groups. However, sharing in the group is voluntary. The program is interspersed with music, prayer, fun activities and general pampering. We expect those in attendance to stay for the entire program. The weekend is Christian in nature, although no religious affiliation is necessary to attend.

Who may attend a Kairos Outside Weekend?

Any adult female whose life has been impacted by the incarceration of a relative or friend is eligible to attend a Kairos Outside weekend. The weekend is not coed. No men, (not even team members) are permitted in the community room with the women during a weekend.

Who presents the Weekend?

The Team is made up of approximately 28 women, 8 men (the cooks!) and 2 clergy women. Many of the team members may be active in the Kairos Prison Ministry in various institutions throughout the state of Indiana and the world. All team members come from many different Christian denominations and are committed to ministering to the incarcerated and their families.

How long is the weekend?

The weekend begins on Friday evening about 6:00 PM and ends on Sunday afternoon around 4:00PM.

What about child care?

Assistance with child care can be provided upon request, based on individual needs.



What is the cost to attend?

There is no cost to the Guests. The funds are provided by local Christian communities.

What are the accommodations during the weekend retreat?

The retreat is held at a local retreat center or camp. The facility provides room and board; everything, except personal articles. Dress is casual and comfortable. Transportation may also be provided, based on needs.

Do guests have to be Christian to attend?

No. All we ask is for the guests to be open to discussions from a Christian perspective.

What should a guest tell a spouse about the men on the team?

The men are present only to prepare and serve the meals. They do not participate in any of the community room activities and they have separate sleeping quarters.

Why should a guest give up a weekend visit with her incarcerated person to attend a Kairos Outside Weekend?

This walk is often difficult. Many people in the outside world do not understand this and may reject those on this journey. This weekend is designed to give support from women who are in the same situation, and from other Christian women who care about the woman and her incarcerated person.

Is a sponsor needed to attend?

No. A team member will contact the guest and be the link to the weekend.
